Education Workshops for Foster Carers of Children in Care¹

Education can be a big ask for children and young people who have experienced a difficult or unsettled start in life, and it is not always easy knowing how best to help them. Come along to develop your knowledge and understanding, meet other foster carers and gain new tools and strategies to help support the child/teenager you care for to make the most of their education opportunities at nursery, school or post 16 provision.

The **Virtual School** has funded **TouchBase** to run the following workshops. They will be facilitated by Michael Reeves, an Integrative Child Psychotherapist and Specialist Teacher on both the TouchBase therapy and education teams.

29th November 2023 Settling to Learn We will focus on how we can help children and young people settle down to learn, particularly at times of change - how we can encourage and support them with practical strategies.

13th March 2024 Control Battles We will think through how, together with education staff, we can support children to let go of their need for control and follow our lead.

12th June 2024 Staying Calm Together, let's think about how we can help children and young people to learn to manage their emotions and find ways of staying calm, so they can make the most of nursery, school and college life.
